Period of Temporary Layoff

If an active LAPP member receives a layoff notice that does not result in a termination of active membership and the member is on leave from all of their duties, the treatment of the period of temporary layoff under LAPP is based on whether the employer considers the temporary layoff **designated or non-designated**.

Updated Affiliation Codes

Employers are required to report Member Affiliation details each year for employees who participate in LAPP. The Affiliation codes are included with year-end details submitted by the employer in the Employer Portal.

Eight new Affiliation codes have been added to the current list, which can be found within:
